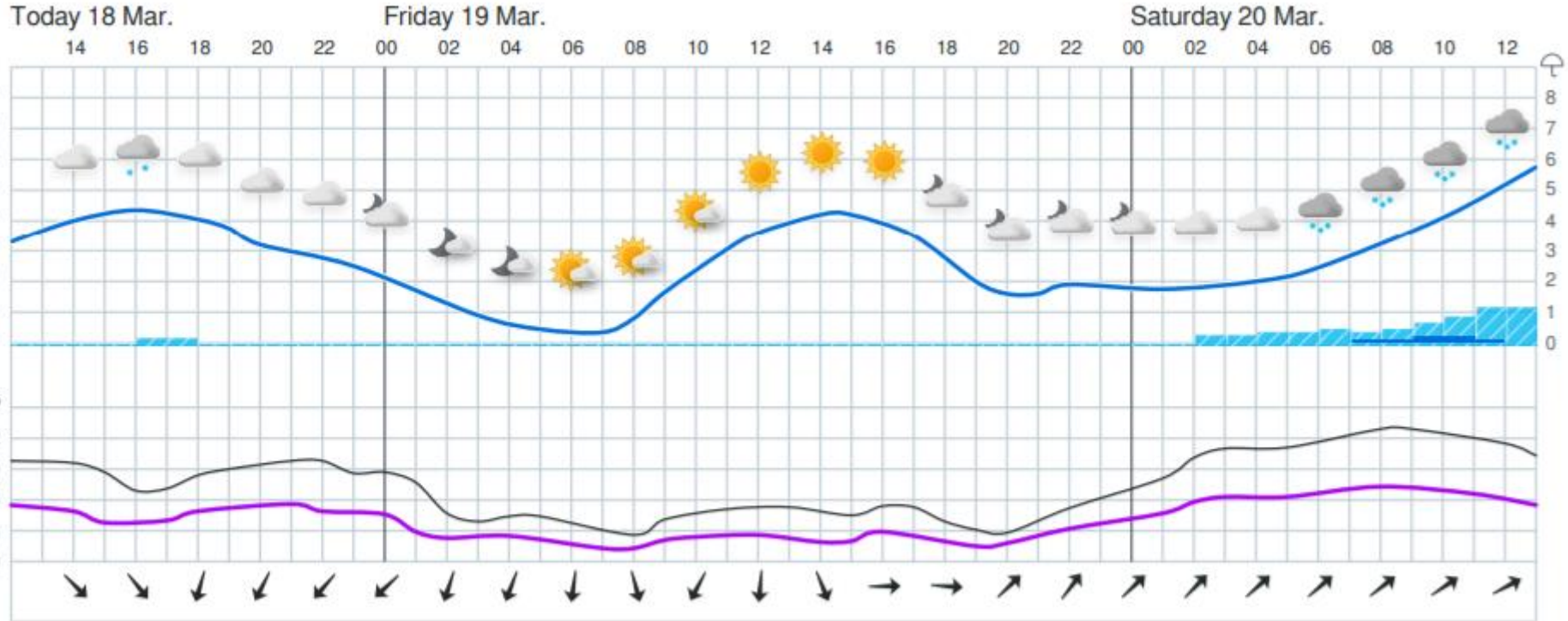

ENTRIES AND START LISTS

- There will be awards for the three best athletes. Please, inform your athletes to not to leave the stadium before you make sure that they are not in top three.



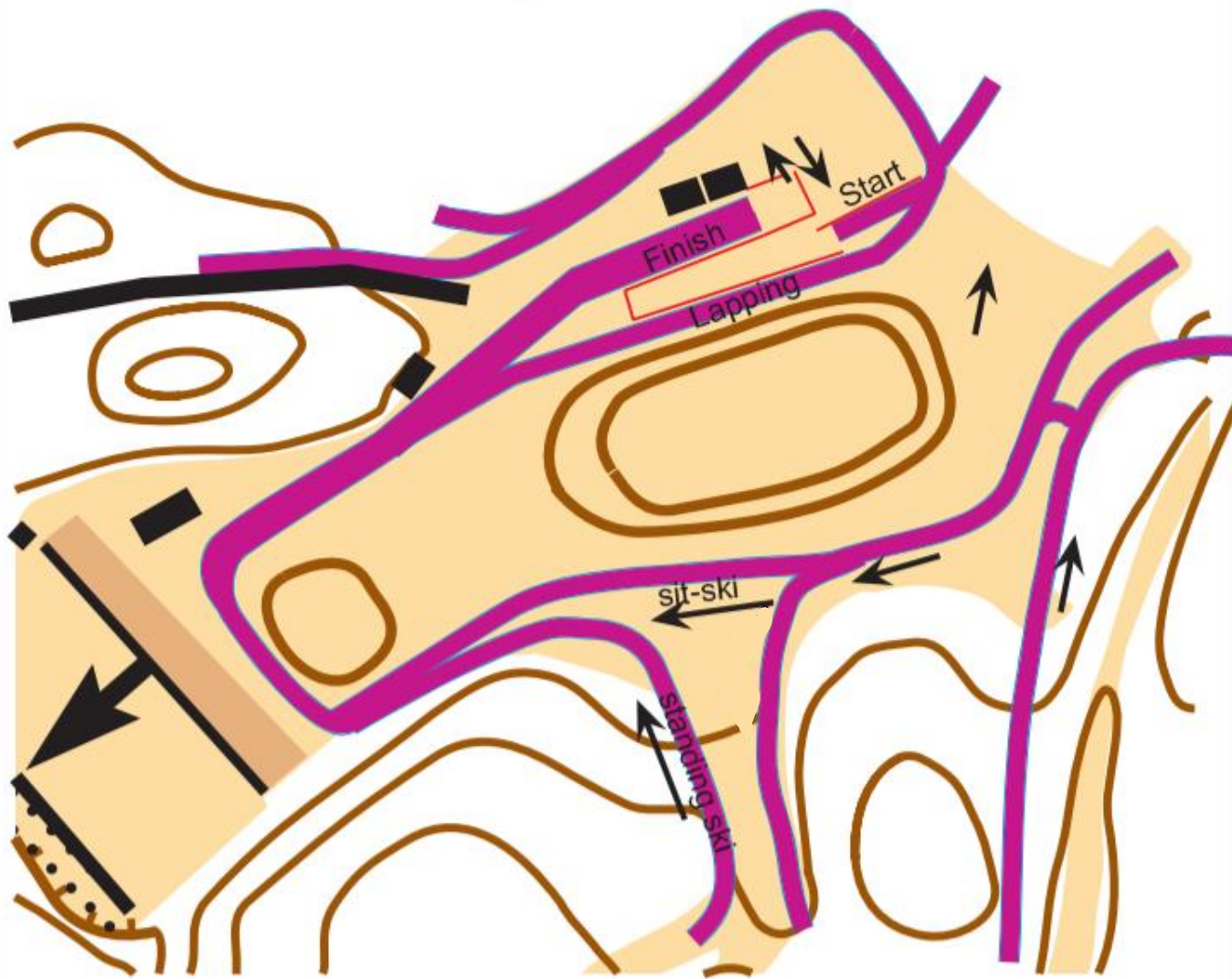
COURSE PREPARATION AND GROOMING

- Forerunners will be used to open and close the course

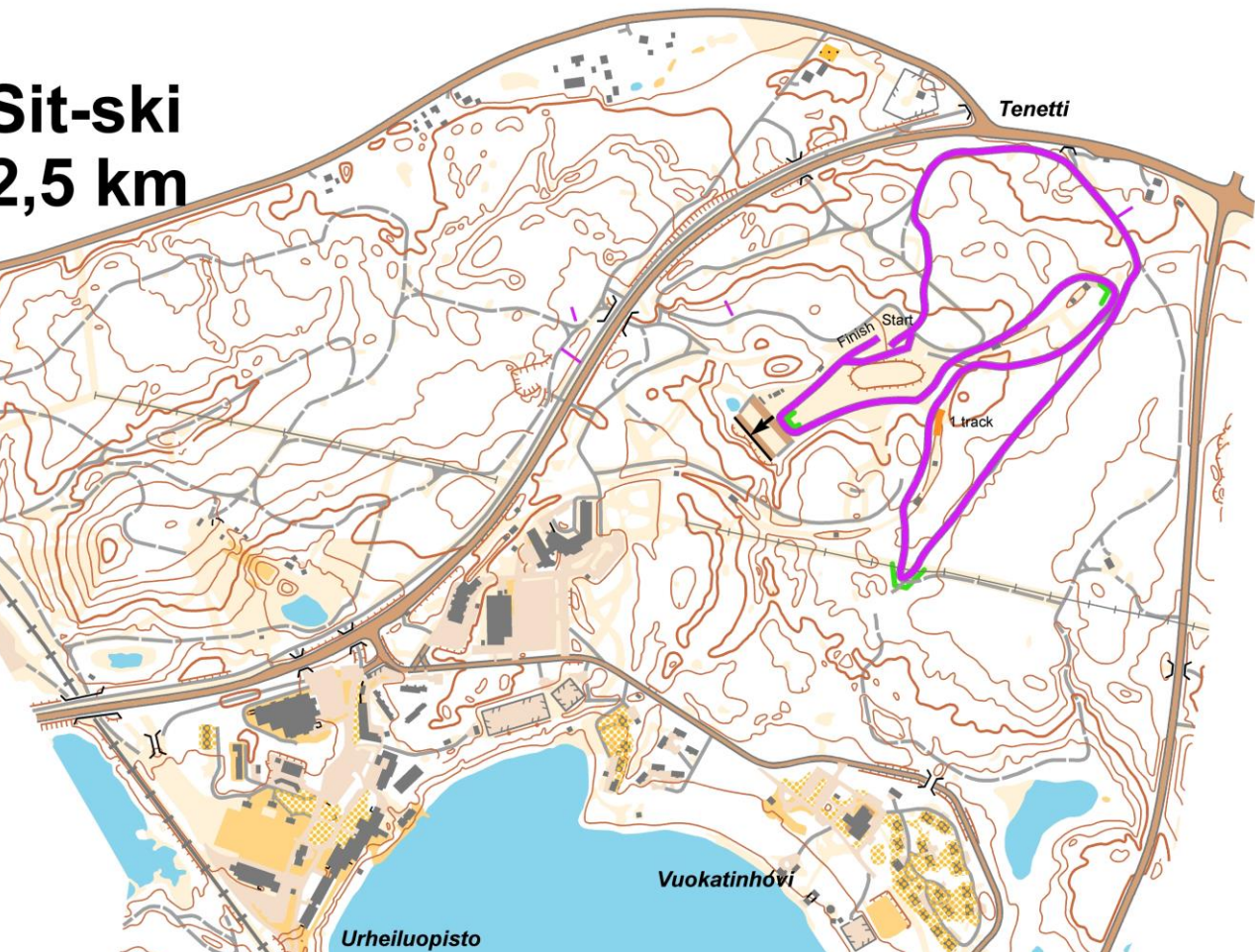
- Two tracks on the course for both sit ski and standing, except on some downhills and corners.

Cross Country Stadium map



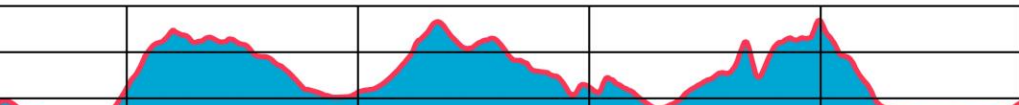
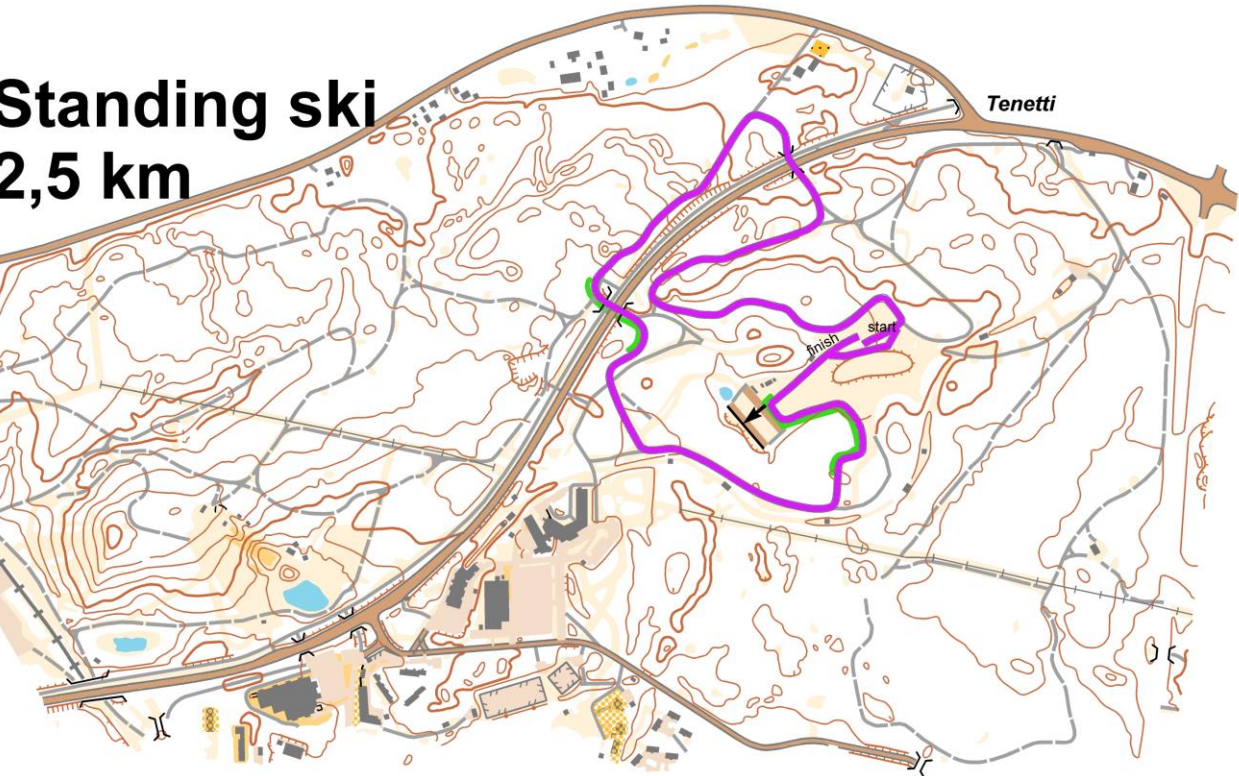
