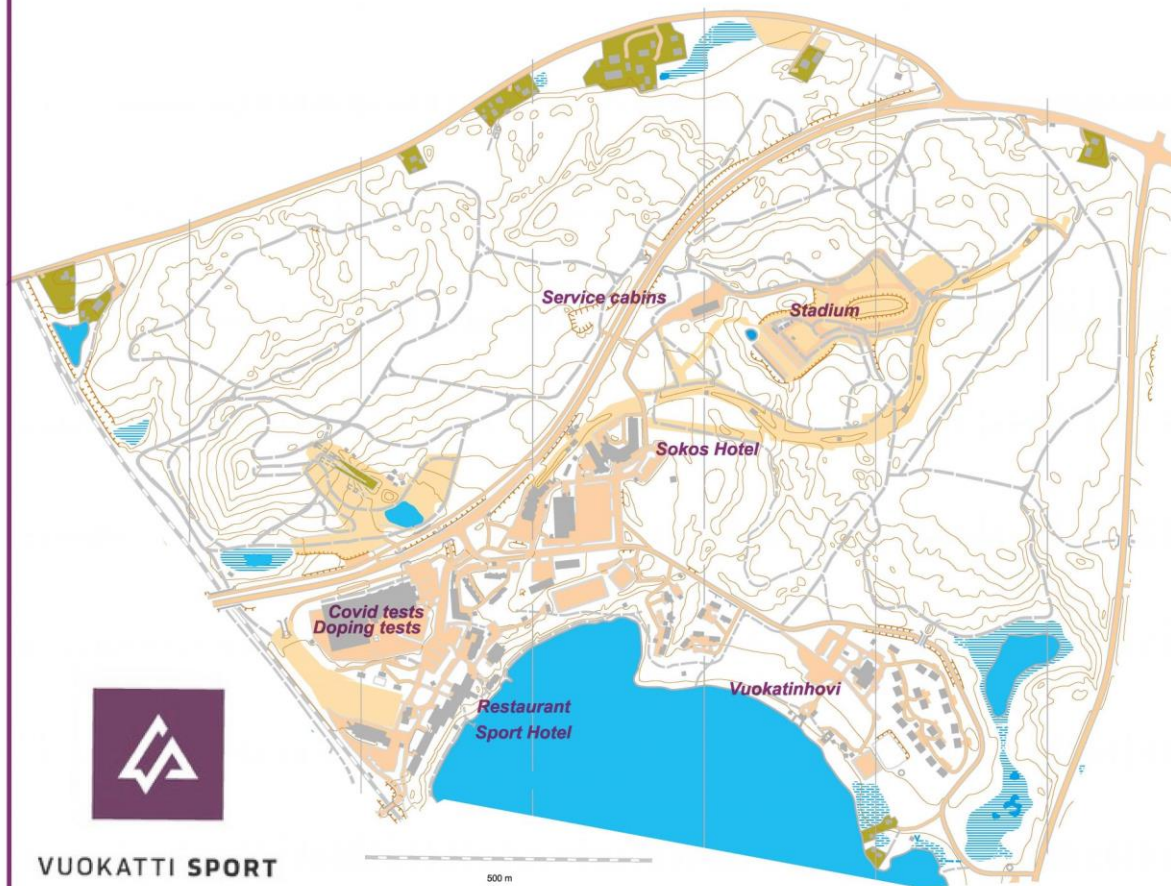

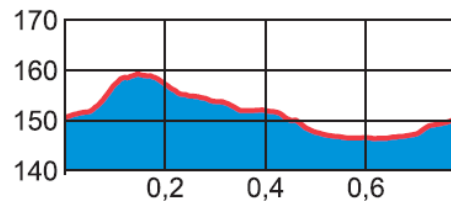

Cross Country Stadium map



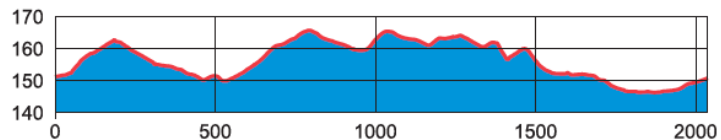
Sit-ski 0,8 km

Sit-ski 2,0 km

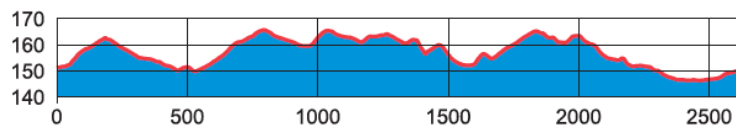


Course length 2035 m

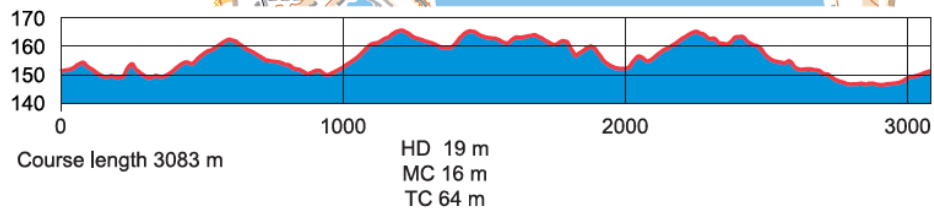
Sit-ski 2,5 km



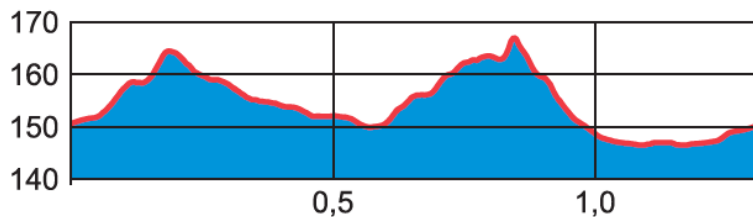

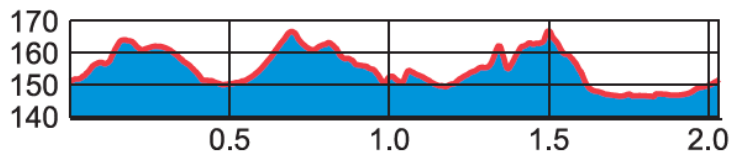
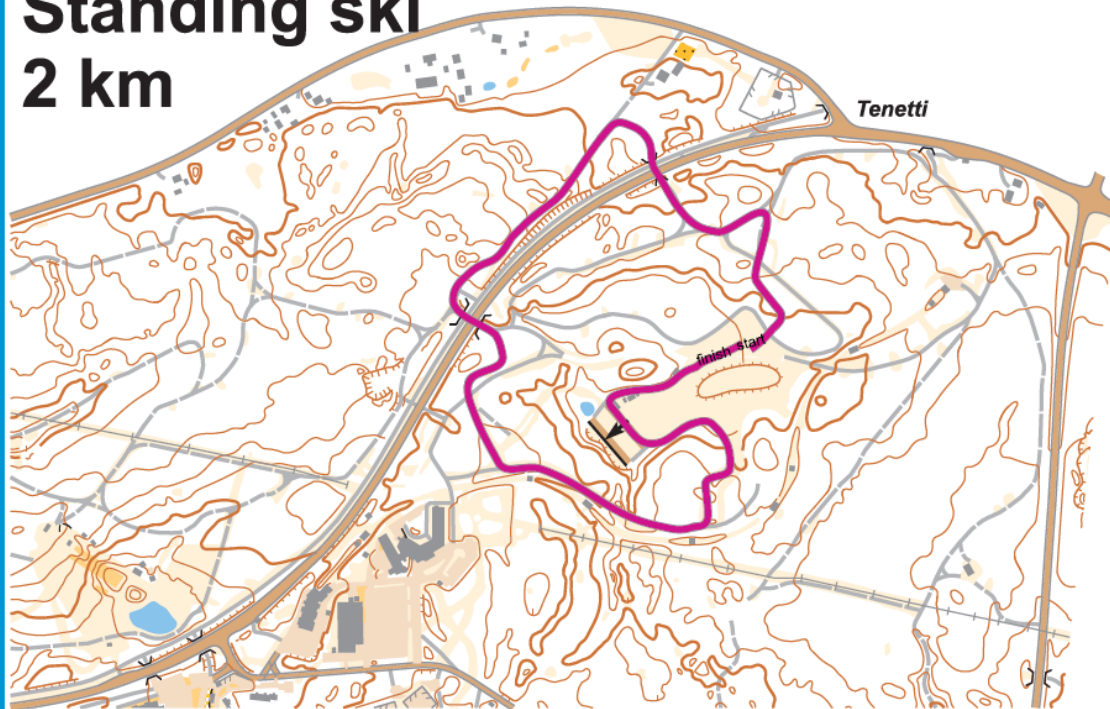
Standing ski 1,2 km

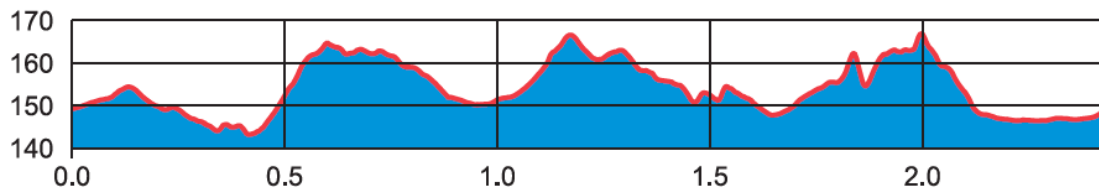
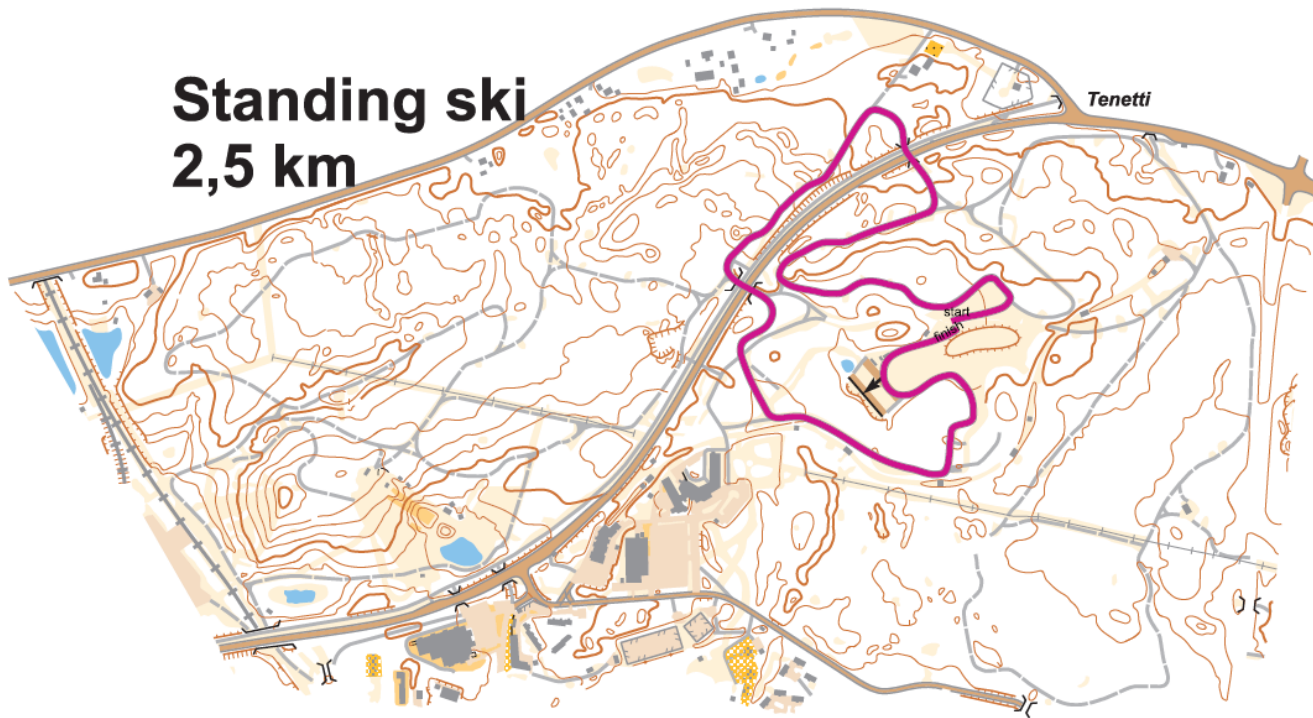
